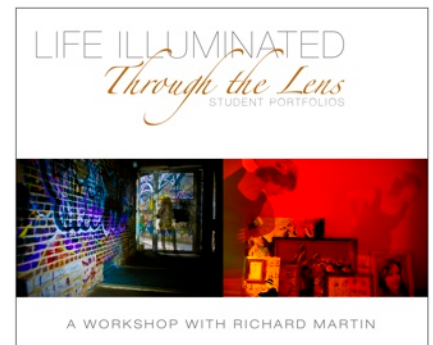
VISION & DISCOVERY YOUNG PHOTOGRAPHERS SUMMER CAMP A Workshop with Richard Martin
